

Blu-ray Tips and Tricks



Your Blu-ray duplicator is capable of copying from disc to disc or from the hard drive to disc.

Disc to Disc

When you copy from disc to disc, you must use one of your burners as a reader. You are therefore able to duplicate one less disc than the number of drives in your duplicator. This is the quickest way to copy short runs.

Here are the settings for copying from Disc to Disc:

Place your master disc in the top drive and the blank discs in the lower drives.

Go to Function 6. Select Source as D#01 and press ENT

Go to Function 1. Copy and press ENT

Copying from the Hard Drive

Copying from the hard drive is the best way to make a large number of copies.

To Record to the hard drive:

Place your master disc in the top drive.

Go to Function 9. HDD Manager and press ENT.

Arrow to 9.2 Disc -> Image and press ENT.

When the disc has completed recording to the hard drive, it will read "finished". The source is automatically set to record from the hard drive to all Blu-ray disc drives.

Remove the master disc. Place blank discs in the disc drives.

Go to Function 1. Copy and press ENT.
