THE CASABLANCA COMMANDMENTS

- 1. Thou shall use the Cassie's front inputs for poor (jittery) source material.
- 2. Thou shall use Y/C (S-vid) cables with connector barrels no longer or with ridges no higher than those that came with your Cassie.
- 3. Thou shall start video source playback before starting Cassie recording, and stop Cassie recording before stopping the video source playback.
- 4. Thou shall leave the hard drive in place any time the Cassie is operating.
- 5. Thou shall **absolutely** assure Kron power during editing operations, preferably with an uninterruptible power supply (UPS).
- 6. Thou shall remember to re-adjust the starting points of any existing audio clips on the Sb to the right of an added video clip.
- 7. Thou shall remember that rendered transitions shorten the video Sb and can affect audio synchronization if rendered *after* adding audio clips.
- 8. Thou shall remember to remove the audio clips from the audio Sb after making a Scene of the rendered audio and video.
- 9. Thou shall copy work in progress to master tape at regular intervals.
- 10. Thou shall perform a Cleanup operation before the hard drive reaches maximum audio or video capacity.
